



Scholarship Guidelines

- All scholarships shall be known as Mandy Wagner Foundation Scholarships.
- Per the Internal Revenue Service, Publication 520, a qualified scholarship is an amount received as a scholarship and may be used according to the condition of the scholarship for:
 - Tuition and fees required to enroll in, or to attend, an educational institution, OR
 - Fees, books, supplies, computers/computer supplies and equipment required for the courses of instruction at the educational institution.
- Scholarships must be applied for on an annual basis.
- There is no limit on the number of years a person may apply.
- No special consideration will be given to previous recipients.
- Recipients of the scholarships shall be chosen annually.
- Availability of scholarship monies will be published through the MWF Foundation website.
- The recipient(s) of a MWF Foundation Scholarship will be notified by July 1.
- The award will be made payable to the college / university of choice OR the recipient.
- The college / university will require the student's signature to process the check.
- The scholarship check will be mailed during July / August directly to the applicant.

In order to apply, you must be:

- A senior high school student who will be an incoming college freshman student with a minimum non-weighted cumulative GPA of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale, OR a minimum score of ACT 22 OR SAT [verbal / critical reading and math] 1030;
- A student presently enrolled in an accredited educational institution / college / university who has maintained a "B" average [3.00 GPA on a 4.00 scale] during his / her college career and be enrolled in a US accredited college / university;
- A student returning to accredited college / university after period of absence from school must have at least a GPA of 3.00 on 4.00 scale;
- Enrolled for training in a technical school or any person returning to school after an absence to retrain job skills or obtain a degree. [Post secondary students at any educational level]
- Enrolled in an online course through an Accredited College / University / Vocational school or an accredited program by an accredited agency to be eligible for online tuition credit.
